• Art. 2 – Participation

- a. Race is by INVITATION and the registration must be done through the dedicated engagement form at least 20 days before the event. The teams can be composed of a minimum of 4 to a maximum of 7 athletes, in accordance with the provisions of the implementing FCI rules.
- b. 72 hours prior to the starting date, the team must confirm the names of the starting cyclists and the names of reserve cyclists.
- c. The Cycling Director is responsible for any athlete and member of the team declared at the moment of the accreditation.
- d. The maximum number of starters is set at 150 athletes.

• Art. 3 – Documentation and approval

Race is held on the illustrated course based on the following documents attached:

- a. Planimetry and altimetry
- b. Hour/kilometer speed table
- c. Altimetry, planimetry and last km details
- d. Direction for cars diversion and written communication regarding the near hospitals, emergency and first aid for all the cycling route.
- f. Planimetry of the finish and start zone with details about: jury, antidoping control, secretary, press room, organization management.

• Art. 4 – Stage quarter / Secretary

Bar Centrale, via Santini 12 Parabiago will be the headquarter for:

- Meeting place
- License verification: will be held on 03/09/2023 from 9:00am to 10:00am
- Head office and Race Management at the finish line

• Art. 5 – Technical meeting

The technical meeting with the Race Director, of Jury College the Cycling Technicians or Company Managers and the Representative of the S.T.F, with the following flagship draw will be held at 10.30am 03 th September 2023, at Bar Centrale via Santini 12 a Parabiago (MI).

• Art. 6 – Race start operation

At 11:50am athletes will start the pre-start operation. Official start will be at 12:00pm

• Art. 7 – Railroad Crossing

No railroad crossing in the race course

• Art. 8 – Race Radio

All the race information will be available channel 33 starting from the car of the President of the Commission. All the vehicles that take part at the race have to be equipped with a dedicated device to receive all the race information.

• Art. 9 - Neutral Technical Assistance

Technical Assistance will be provided by SERVIZIO CORSE BERGAMO-VISION duly supplied through 3 vehicles with spare wheels and bicycles available in various sizes. Assistance can be provided also by the team vehicle for all the athletes of the team.

Wheels change by motorbike is not allowed.

• Art. 10 – Feeding

Riders might be supplied with refreshments directly from the vehicles of their own Team, or from pedestrian members of the team starting from the 30th kilometer after the start and up to twenty kilometers remaining to the finish.

For all the laps the feeding zone is Via San Michele

• Art. 11 – Time limit

The riders who exceed 8% of the winner's time on arrival will not be classified. The maximum time may be increased by the Board of Commissaires' Panel after consulting the Organizer in the event of exceptional circumstances.

• Art. 12 – Ranking

- Individual ranking
- Intermediate Sprint, till 10th lap, placed under the finish line sign

• Art. 13 – Awards

Based on the national tables, awards will be assigned till the 10th cyclist. All the awards fall under the fiscal Italian tax rules. Award payment will be done at the end of the race at Bar Centrale via Santini 12 a Parabiago (MI).

• Art. 14 – Antidoping

Anti-doping control will be made at Bar Maggiolini via santini 12. Additional control can be done in accordance with the Italian dedicated legislation.

• **Art. 15 – Protocol Ceremony**

The first three winners have to show up in the dedicated space within 10 minutes by the end of the race.

• **Art. 16 – Penalty**

Infringements assessed during the Race will only be sanctioned according to the scale of penalties referred to in the UCI Regulations, and to the Prospetto Unico Infrazioni e Sanzioni (PUIS).

• **Art. 17 – Medical Service**

The Medical Service, appointed by the Race Director, is formed by two ambulances. Dr. Capobianco Mario is the resuscitator doctor. Hospital near the race course are Ospedale Civile di Legnano – Rho – Gallarate – Busto Arsizio - Castellanza – Cuggiono (see the list).

• **Art. 18 – Ecologia**

The Organizer aims at making the race “eco-friendly” and sustainable and is fully committed to respect the environment by embracing the UCI vision and project. The dedicated green area for the race waste will be the same for all the laps Via San Michele

• **Art. 19 – Codice della Strada**

Athletes, teams and drivers and all the officially accredited vehicles following the race are required to strictly observe the Road Code “Codice della Strada”. The cycling technician, or club manager, is the manager of the athletes and team members, officially communicated to the organization at the time of accreditation. The event will be open and closed by cars with the signs "START CYCLING RACE" and "END OF CYCLING RACE"

• **Art. 20 – Composizione del Collegio di Giuria**

The college of Jury is composed as specified on the FC site.

- **Art. 21 – Rules for re-schedule**

The Panel of Jury will apply the regulations of the U.C.I., of the F.C.I. and the laws of the Italian State as applicable.

- **Art. 22 - Submission/Appeal Teams and Athletes.**

The starters will be confirmed at the license check. The presentation/appeal of teams and athletes/ athletes is introduced and must end 10 minutes before the start. The organizer is advised to prepare a presentation order with imposed times.

Race Manager Communication

- DS meting: 10:30 am with Race Direction and Jury c/o Central Bar via Santini (draw flagships in tow)
 - Queue: 11:50 am Athletes and cars in tow, on the finish line.
 - Race Start: 12:00 am
 - Teams presentation at 11:00 am at Piazza Maggiolini
 - Awarding of the first three finishers of the team of the first classified and of the flying finish line (show up 10 minutes after arriving at the awards stage)
 - Race protection and safety: N° 8 motorbike
 - Mechanical assistance: N° 3 neutral vehicles equipped under the FCI rules.
 - Radio Race : Canale 33
 - Race course: flat city circuit of 9.70Km to be repeated 15 times for a total of 145.5. The traffic dividers and roundabouts will be approached in the normal traffic direction . Along the circuit there is no blocking of traffic but the temporary suspension of traffic; it is therefore recommended to pay attention during the course of the event.
 - Feeding: from the 3rd lap to the end of the 14th lap.
 - Late athletes:
Athletes considered very late by the main group and / or overtaken by the “End of Race” car, for safety reasons, will be subjected to compulsory withdrawal by the Race Director. They will therefore have to REMOVE THE NUMBER (backbone and helmet) and set off upon arrival, RESPECTING THE ROAD CODE. Article 81 TECHNICAL REGULATION applies.
 - Finish line: last km will be straight with an average length of 6 meters. Photofinish service, please use the two numbers on the helmet.
 - Anti-doping: at Bar centrale in via santini, follow the directions.
 - Hospital: Rho (ca 10 Km), Legnano (Ospedale Nuovo, ca 8 Km) and Busto Arsizio (ca 15 Km).

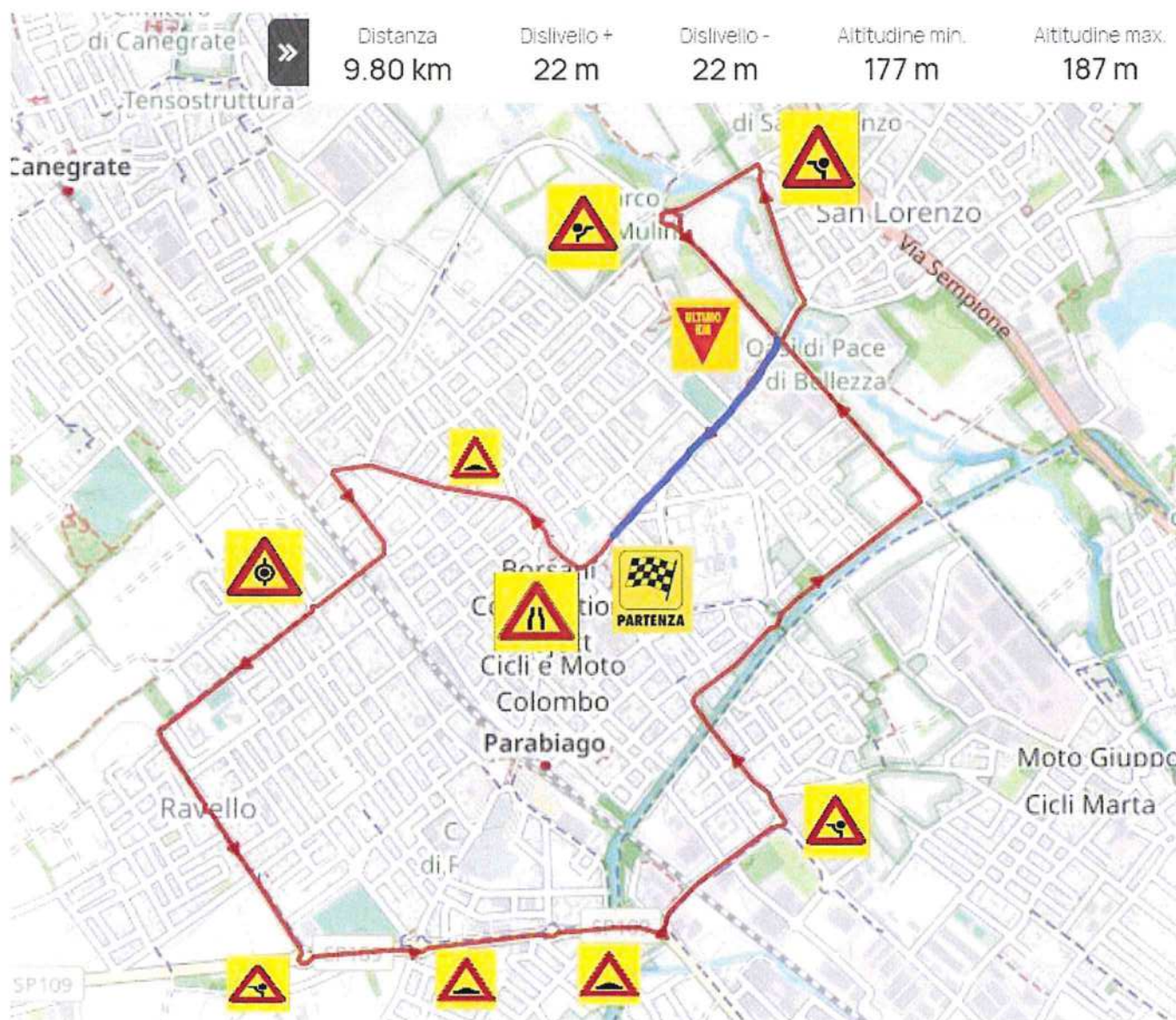

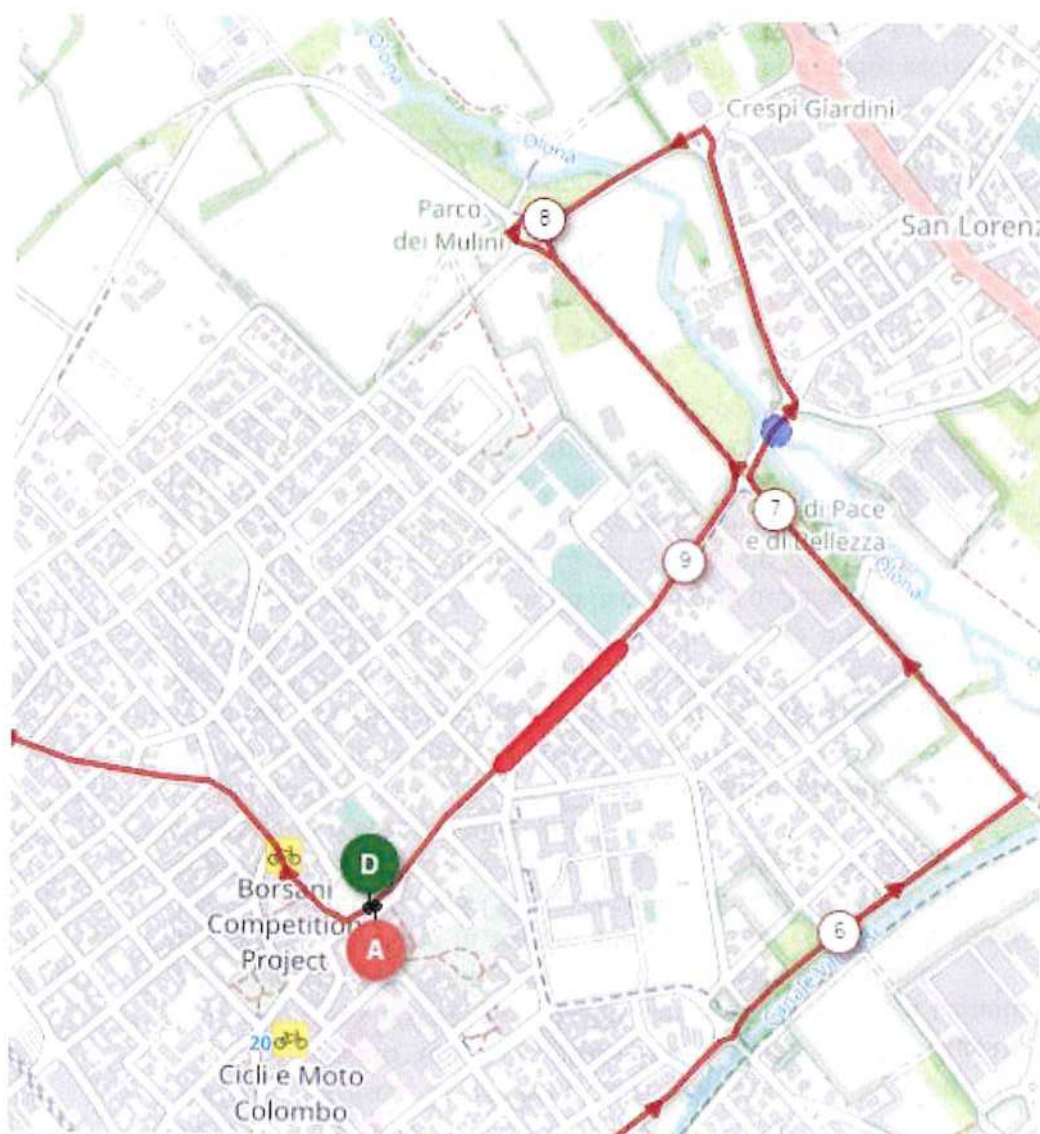

- Attention section with narrowing of the roadway in Red

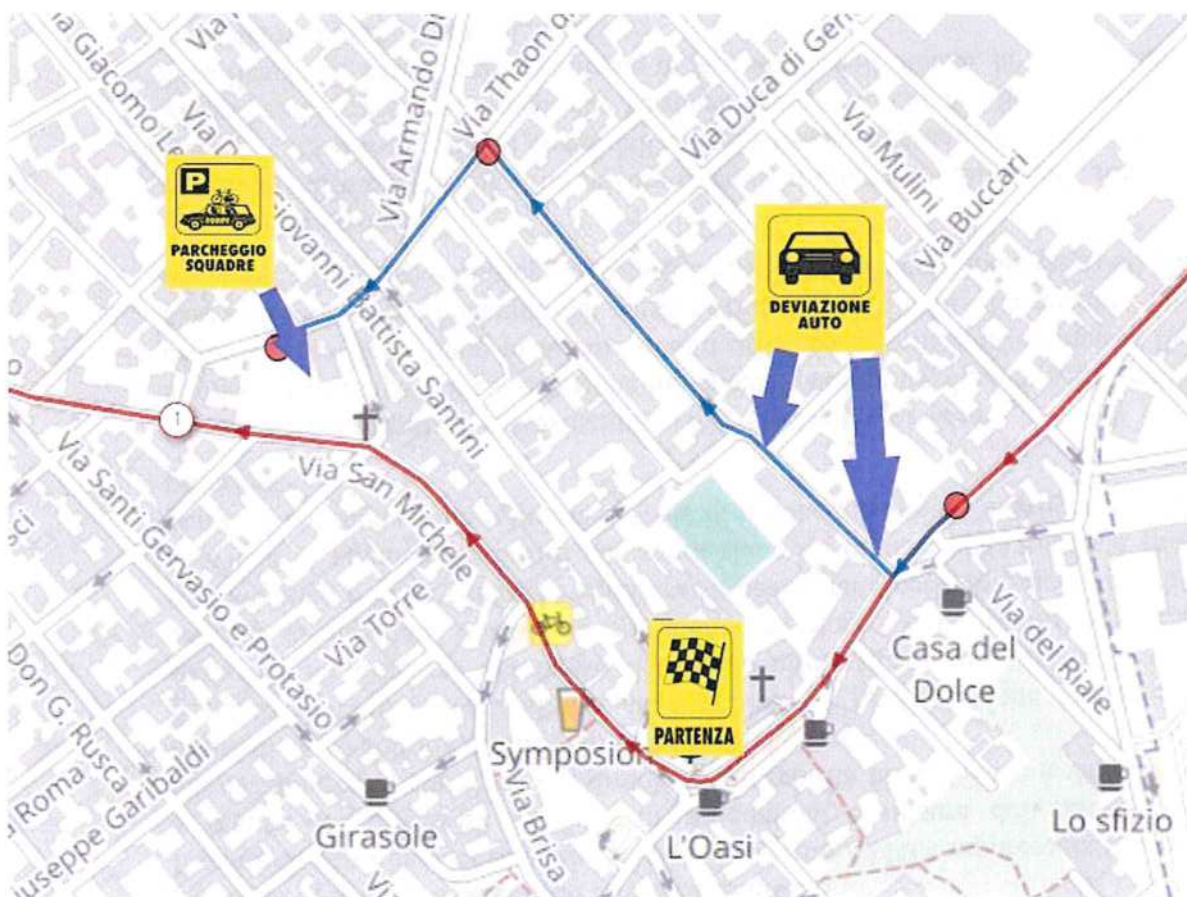
